## About Grand Rapids, MI

Abundant with the waters of the Grand River, located near Lake Michigan, and home to many lakes in-between, the variety of recreation and scenery around Grand Rapids is as vast as the projects that you'll be a part of. In a city that preserves historic homes and covered bridges and relishes in a history of its Native American ancestors, maritime traditions and furniture-making legacy, you'll get to be part of a grand tradition for it's current residents. And, although Grand Rapids stands as Michigan's second largest city and is host to numerous cultural and industrial interests, it also plays host to many of the issues that confront big cities across the United States. Your service will inspire hope and bring Christ's love to the elderly, children and individuals in need in this grand city.

**Nature of Projects:** Our group will partner with local churches, service agencies, and homeowners. And over the four days, your help will bolster the efforts of the ongoing work in these communities. You'll learn new skills, serve in important roles, and have loads of fun as you: help people with projects in their home...assist the elderly...tutor struggling kids...conduct a backyard Bible club...serve at a food bank...staff an activities camp for disabled children...spruce up the grounds of a financially strapped social service agency...engage children at a day camp...and improve the community in other important ways.

**Project Crew Structure:** Project crews typically stay with the same project for the entire week, creating an environment where meaningful relationships develop. You and your group will make new friends while serving on project teams with people from other churches. Or, if you desire, we can keep you together with people from your own group...just let the Registration team know so we can make proper arrangements. The number of people working on a given project varies based on the project needs.

**PROGRAM:** You'll applaud the daily programs and devotions. Each evening, everyone will gather for a time of intimate, interactive, God-centered worship with music, Scripture, video, drama, and hands-on activities. Programs are coordinated by a staff member, but you, your group, and other groups will take the lead in sharing music (so bring your guitar and best song leader voices).

## How will we get there?

Grand Rapids is about a four and a half hour trip. We will travel in vans. Participants will determine a fun group activity for the trip home to celebrate God's goodness.

**Who can go?** Youth ages 12 and up.

## What will it cost?

Our estimated total cost is \$500 per person.

In order to register for the trip each individual must make a \$200 deposit.

**In order to benefit from fundraisers, you must participate in fundraisers.** Each fundraiser profit will be divided among participants (youth and adults). Youth families will be responsible for the balance after fundraising is complete.
